## **Who Can Receive**

### **FREE Influenza Vaccine?**

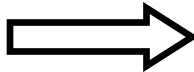
**ALL CHILDREN** 6 months old through age 18, regardless of insurance status

### **Vaccine Type Available?**

- Injectable (shot)

### **Can Adults (age 19+) Receive Influenza Vaccine?**

- Yes, but the vaccine is not free



## **What Are The Payment Options for Adults?**

- We can **bill your insurance** or you can **pay out-of-pocket**
- We accept:
  - ⇒ Security Health Plan
  - ⇒ Security Administrative Services
  - ⇒ Medicaid/BadgerCare+
  - ⇒ Advocare
  - ⇒ Medicare
- You **MUST** present your insurance card(s) at the clinic

### **Self-Pay Option For Adults:**

- ⇒ \$30.00/dose
- ⇒ Cash or check only please
