Vaccine Cost for Adults

(19 and over)

- ◆ **Adult Hepatitis B:**
 - Cost: \$45.00/dose (3 doses total)
- ◆ **Adult Seasonal Influenza:**
 - Cost: \$30.00
- ◆ **TB Skin Test:**
 - Cost: \$15.00
- ◆ **Td and Tdap:**
 - Cost: Free (Donations Welcome)
 - (Only to those that have no health insurance or do not have coverage for vaccine with current health insurance)

Vaccines For Children (VFC) Program Eligibility

Children through 18 years of age who meet at least one of the following criteria are eligible to receive VFC vaccine:

- ◆ **Medicaid eligible:** A child who is eligible for the Medicaid program
 - (For the purposes of the VFC program, the terms "Medicaid-eligible" and "Medicaid-enrolled" are the same and refer to children who have health insurance covered by a state Medicaid program)
- ◆ **Uninsured:** A child who has no health insurance coverage
- ◆ **American Indian or Alaska Native:** As defined by the Indian Health Care Improvement Act (25 U.S.C. 1603)
- ◆ **Underinsured:** Has health insurance, but the coverage does not include all vaccines or only covers selected vaccines. Speak with your local health department for specific eligibility requirements.

Please Bring all Immunization Records with you to Clinic Site!

(All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian)
